1	Review of actions from previous meeting & AGM
2	The numbers Membership: we have done well with the renewals so far & currently with 35. Bidon's we now have 54 in stock. Accounts: the April balance received see us on £1570 with more AGM expenses, membership renewals to be added plus £25 in hand.
3	Club Leisure Rides: a devised shared rota between PC, MM & NB was decided to instigate with immediate effect for Sunday's & Wednesday's.
4	Away Day Ride: Bristol/Cheddar, 19 th May, a new route has been posted that both groups will use with the C's to head out first and all to meet at the cafe stop. A meeting has been held to sort the travel arrangements and the numbers are looking good with 18 attending so far.

12	Early Ride Start Times: NB requested a 8:30 start but decided to leave as 9:00 following a brief discussion, Cafe opening times the main issue.
13	A Ride Discipline: a concern of Phil & PH lead to the long decision which led to a change to the speed bands for the summer, A 17-19, B 15-17 & C 13-15 mph. Also the RL's must have a post ride discussion chat to reinforce the group discipline within any ride, mileage, cafe etc.
