It has been good to report that we have had a Swan Wheeler, Chris Cox doing a great attempt at riding **Cyclocross** in the Central League in the **Vet Men's 50** races, which are held over 40 minutes, the season is a short one & held during later summer - winter months. There are classifications for men & women and ages from Under 8's through to Vet 60's'. It's well worth a look if you are passing; there's good racing, a great bunch of people, food & coffee plus loo's are available too.

Here is a final report for Chris's season in which he managed 34<sup>th</sup> in his class out of a total of 121 entrants.

The seasons' racing was fast and furious in the early season, due to the dry conditions but of course that changed as autumn turned into winter, I had a nervous feeling on the first start grid with some familiar faces and a few new ones to compete against.

**ROUND 1:** Milton Keynes Bowl (Team MK): where Chris was more than pleased with a result of 18<sup>th</sup> out of 90 entrants.

**Round 2**: Campbell Park MK (Velo Bants) this is a great course and the venue for the world cup. Chris finished 21/140, losing time due to a slide and tangle with marker tape. Happy with the result and a Sprint finish racking up some good points in the process

Round 3: Kettering: he had good start from back of the grid to finished 13<sup>th</sup>/72

**Round 4:** MK Bowl (Luton CC), finished 13<sup>th</sup>/65, lost time coming off twice in greasy conditions.

Chris missed next 3 rounds.. 5 Kingston Whrs, 6 Hemel Hampstead & 7 Leighton Buzzard

**Round 8:** Whipsnade (Icknield Cross CC) thought it was a good course & finished 24<sup>th</sup>/80. It was a hard race and I went backwards after 2 laps, I thought that may happen as I had not been on a bike for 4 weeks.

(PaulW) A post from a Bossard Wheelers mate... "More cyclocross agony, on the long grass and muddy ruts of Whipsnade this time and the short grass and adverse chambers of Leighton Buzzard (#7) from the week before."

Next 2 events are local:

**Round 9**: Sat 17Nov: MK Bowl (Corley Cycles) this event saw Chris completing 6 laps the same as the winner back in 31<sup>st</sup> place out of a field of some 81 entrants, a little too dry and fast for my liking Chris's said.

**Round 10:** Sun 25Nov: Swanbourne House School (JCA Equipe Velo) for 6 lap race it had 90 entrants competing with Chris completing 5 laps back in 54<sup>th</sup>.

## Eastern & Central Regional Championships

Sun 2<sup>nd</sup> Dec, Stanborough Park, Hertford, this event saw 86 entrants in this 4 lap race which Chris completed in 49<sup>th</sup> spot.

**Round 11:** Sun 6Dec18, Hillingdon (Hillingdon) Chris managed 5 laps for this event and finished 54<sup>th</sup> out of 90 entrants for Chris this was his last ride of the season & no more points towards the championship.

Round 12: this event was cancelled,

Round 13: Sun 6Jan19, Corby (Rockingham Forest) - 12 participants only Chris, Round 14: Sun 20Jan, Lutterworth (Welland Valley)- 11 participants only, Round 15: Sun 27Jan, Hillingdon (WDMBC) - 42 entrants for the final race in the series

Whilst not able to enter the last few rounds Chris is looking forward to competing next season.
