2	<p>Website etc: to support a busy SB, PW had some training (limited) so thanks to PatH, and I've step-up to help and made a few minor script changes here & there where necessary, and refreshed the home page to inc. a monthly Photo Competition and also adding in the new RL Roto..</p> <p>A new Club Event calendar is under construction, to be posted soon. (TS/PW)</p> <p>NOTE: we are still looking to fill our Web Admin role so if any of you have the skills and able to help with this role it would be greatly appreciated.</p>
