In the interests of "doing something epic" — A Club Day Trip to the Isle of Wight on 16th September is in the planning. The plan is to get up early, get down to Lymington for 9am, jump on the ferry and cycle starting and finishing at Yarmouth.

We are looking to cater for as many as we can with 2 rides planned:

1) A GF 65 miles around the whole island in the 15 -16 mph band, so some 5 hours plus stops 2) A 45 miler in the 14 – 15 mph band, so some 4 hours plus a stop.
